I have posted numerous new "real" chicken and cockateel pysanky easter eggs for sale. Making patterns for pysanky is really not easy. I have found few good examples of pysanky patterns on the internet, but they are not too accessible to download; the fun ones are animated gif files, but that doesn't lend itself to easy use as a pattern. I devised a method which might be workable and I put it on the internet as a trial for anyone to assess.

The BONUS is, that you don't have to have done pysanky to look over the pattern, and it is free, (just go through normal checkout) and in appreciation for your feedback about the ease of understanding my pysanky pattern format I will send you a free stained glass pattern of your choice.
