I am personally grateful for the **UNDO** option that comes with forgiveness, which is about as close as the "real world" can come to the computer **UNDO** option.

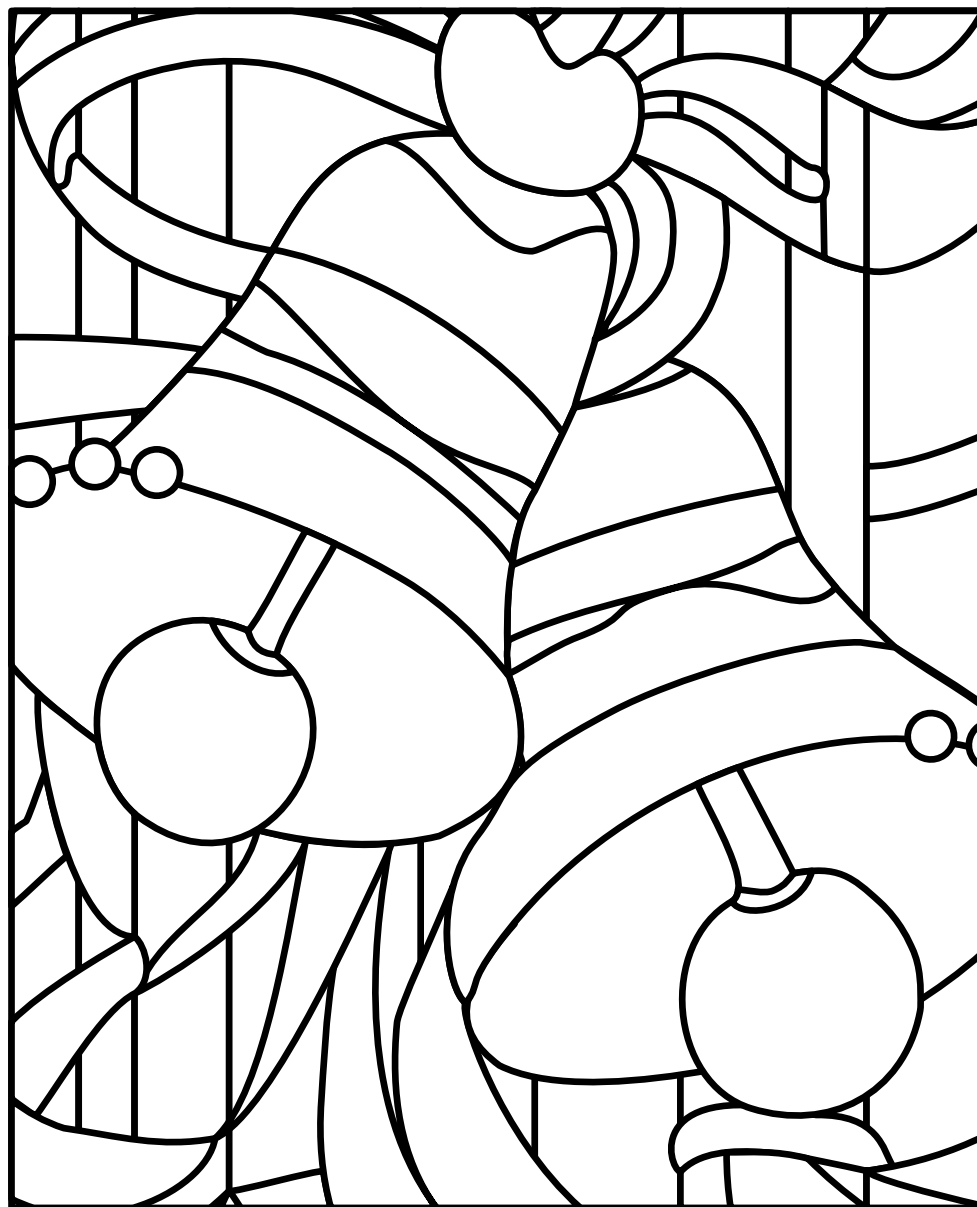
